YPW SPANISH WORKSHOP PROGRAMS

Chiquitos Ages 3 to 5 - Mommy and Me Workshop – Class size: 4 to 10 students

This is a weekly 45 minutes series of mixed-aged workshops for preschoolers.

Spanish is fun! Parents join the young people learning Spanish through songs, playing physically active games such as “Simon Says” and charades, creating artistic projects, and playing games like memory, bingo and dominoes. A vocabulary based on words encountered in daily life is the building block of this YPW Full-Immersion Spanish program for Young People. It is common for young people in this age group to repeat workshops before gaining full mastery of the material.

Chicos: Ages 5 to 12 – Class size: 4 to 10 students

This is a weekly 90 minutes series of mixed-aged workshops for kinder to third grade and fourth to sixth grade students.

Students learn Spanish through story telling, games, songs, and activities related to their own experiences. The Chicos workshop is designed to gradually enable students to attain proficiency in speaking, listening, reading and writing. Young people will be fully exposed to the Spanish language and benefit from learning in this “Spanish-only” environment. It is common for young people in this age group to repeat workshops before gaining full mastery of the material.

The 1.5-hour weekly session is divided into 3 segments:

1st segment is @35 mins long. Students are taught new vocabulary and new sentence structures, learning speaking, reading and writing in the classroom.

2nd segment is @35 mins long. Students participate in one or two of the following cultural and science activities: Art & Crafts, Cooking, Dancing and various STEM projects. They will focus on the vocabulary and sentence structures students have learned.

3rd segment is @20 mins long. Students review new vocabulary and new sentence structures, learning speaking, reading and writing in the classroom.

Muchachos: Ages 12 – 18 - Class size: 4 to 10 students

This is a weekly 90 minutes series of mixed-aged workshops for seventh to twelve grade students.

This program has 5 levels. By the end of Level 4, the student is ready to take the AP Spanish test and SAT subject Spanish test. In average, it takes 5 years to finish the 5 levels. Students take this class once per week for 1.5 hours.

Levels

Level 1 => This level is designed to introduce the student to the Spanish language through listening, speaking, reading, writing, and culture. There is a very strong emphasis on oral communication skills. Classes will be conducted primarily in Spanish. There will be occasions in which English is used (such as explanation of a concept or classroom management). The goal, however, is immersion in the target language. Upon successful completion of Spanish I the student should be able to communicate using the skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing in the range of Novice-Low to Novice-High according to the ACTFL Proficiency Guidelines.

Level 2 => This level is a continuation of level 1. This course continues the emphasis on oral communication based on the framework set up in level 1. Listening, reading, and writing will also continue to be developed. This level includes the study of cultures of Spanish-speaking countries.

Level 3 => Pre-AP focuses on concentrated practice of the language skills. Spanish is exclusively the language of this workshop. English is used by the teacher to clarify difficult concepts. Active participation by the student is an essential part of this workshop. Emphasis is placed on the student’s communicative skills and fluency. All four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing, continue to be developed as well as a better understanding of Hispanic and Spanish cultures.

Level 4 => Continuation of Level 3. This workshop emphasizes communicating in three ways or “modes”: understanding Spanish when you read or hear it (interpretive communication), being able to present information in Spanish either by speaking or writing it (presentational communication), and communicating back and forth with someone else in Spanish (interpersonal communication). The goal for students is to be able to understand and communicate about simple, everyday topics. Communication is guided by the learned vocabulary and support structures taught throughout the workshop. Class participation in the target language is essential in order to develop this oral proficiency. Language is presented within the context of the Spanish-speaking world with some emphasis on geography and culture of Spanish-speaking countries.

Level 5 => This level is designed for students wishing to continue the study of Spanish without participating in the Advanced Placement program. Students will continue to develop communication skills through a variety of written and oral activities as well as increase their knowledge of Hispanic culture and history. As in Spanish IV, Spanish is used exclusively by the teacher and students. Active participation, especially speaking, by the student is an essential part of the course.

Adults: Ages 18+ – Class size: 3 to 10 students

This is a weekly 2 hour workshop. We offer private or group classes. Private classes are highly customized to each student’s needs. Students can start any time. Group classes focus on conversational and reading skills.

YPW WORKSHOPS POLICIES

YPW Offers beginner to advanced level Spanish workshops for you and your young people from preschool, high school to adults.

"Full-Immersion" means the workshops including all instructions and activities are conducted entirely in Spanish. Even beginner students quickly become comfortable with this method of learning and absorb the Spanish language at a much quicker rate than if learning by hearing two languages concurrently. As with all the workshops at YPW, the Full-Immersion Spanish workshops are "hands-on" fun. Young People learn through singing songs, role-playing, and playing games. Visual aids help further the learning process. Each student is encouraged to participate verbally during question-and-respond sessions. We also offer non-academic Spanish and Culture program for high school and adults. This program is specially designed to meet your individual goals. While participating in meaningful and practical activities. Thanks to our carefully developed curriculum, special method, small classes and our excellent team of native speaking teachers, you or your young people will learn Spanish naturally, in a fun, engaging environment

REGISTRATION

\$49 material fee per student and per session and full tuition is required with the registration form to reserve a space in the workshop. Registration is not considered complete and class space is not reserved until these fees are paid. Registration & Material fees are non-refundable / non-transferable. There are NO refunds or adjustments due to absences

TUITION

No refunds or adjustments due to absences, vacations or holidays. Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable. Make-up classes are encouraged.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

INCLEMENT WEATHER

CLASS SIZE AND TEACHER ASSIGNMENT

Class size is normally a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 10 students. Exceptions may be made in unusual circumstances at the discretion of the director, and occasionally make-ups may contribute to more than ten per class. Teacher absences will normally be covered by a substitute from our faculty.

CDS, SONGBOOKS, BOOKLETS for Mommy and Me workshops

Play your CDs at home and in the car as frequently as possible, especially during the first weeks of class. Make it available for your child to listen to while she/he is playing, riding in the car, and before nap or bedtime. Use the songbook to help you remember the songs and you can also play along with an instrument. At bedtime or naptime, try using the songbook instead of a regular book

WORKBOOKS - WORKSHEETS for "Chicos" and "Muchachos" workshop

YPW Workshops students are expected to reinforce what they have learned at home. Its important for the students to finish and then daily review the worksheets.

SIBLING POLICIES

Older siblings may visit once per semester, pre-arranged with the office and teacher. Any child attending class on a regular basis must be registered for class. Babies 10 months and under at the time of registration are admitted free with a registered sibling. Please provide your baby's name and birth date.

DRINKS ONLY IN CLASS

Liquids are fine to have in class (water bottles, "no-spill" sippy cups, or regular bottles). Please respect our facility (as well as those with food allergies) by keeping food out of the classroom. Be sure to place coffee cups in a high, safe place.

ILLNESS Please be sure to sanitize your hands before and after class to help keep our environment as free of germs as possible! Please do not bring yourself or your child to class if anyone has a contagious illness. The rule with fevers: you and your child must be free of a fever for 24 hours without using a fever reducer medicine before you can return.

CHILDREN'S WORK AREA

Please show your child how to restore their work. A large part of the YPW classroom is putting ones work away before getting out another piece of work. Even the young toddlers enjoy creating order. Encourage your child to put one item away where they found it before getting out something else. You can show by example: giving a lesson without saying a word. Thank you for helping us create an organized environment for our children.

TALKING IN CLASS

Please be mindful of not talking when you are in class. This will help keep it a "Learning Only Zone" and allow everyone the opportunity to get the most out of their experience in class while singing and participating in the various activities together.

CELL PHONES AND CAMERAS

Please limit your use of cell phones and cameras for taking pictures as this is distracting for other families in class, and it also keeps you from being completely present during the workshop. Please remember to turn off the ringer on your cell phones before the workshop.

WORKSHOP ATTENDANCE

Class attendance is a vital part of the YPW Spanish Workshop program. Students participation in class assists greatly in planning properly for that student. We also introduce new concepts in class so we may assist you or your student in reaching his/her goals. If a student is unable to attend workshop, please email the School by 1:00 pm on the day of class so we can prepare the work to be picked up. This will also allow us to make adjustments to the student's lesson plan for the future.

WORKLOAD

The Instructor determines the amount of worksheets assigned to you or to your student; however, student and parental feedback helps with this process. It is important that the student is given an amount of homework that can be completed comfortably on a daily basis. Please contact the School 24 hours prior to the workshop to discuss any adjustments or concerns regarding yours or your child's YPW Workshop experience.

CLASS RULES

In order to ensure that you and each student receives the maximum learning experience during each School visit, we have established the following classroom rules for students and parents:

- Do not bring food and/or drink into the School.
- Walk at all times while in the School.
- Use a quiet, classroom voice
- Respect other people's belongings.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Be considerate of the right of others to learn.
- Treat all students, staff, and the Instructor in a respectful manner.
- Discuss any problems you are having with the Instructor.
- Remember to try your best at all times.

Parents please...

- Make class time a priority each week.
- Use a quiet, classroom voice while waiting.
- Communicate any concerns you are having with the Instructor (outside of class hours).

COMMUNICATION

This is an important tool in enhancing and accelerating your student's progress. We solicit two way feedback between parents, students and the school. Parent Conferences are scheduled in spring and fall. In addition, you may request a meeting at any time outside of class to discuss your student's progress in the program. Please note that Instructors are not available for conferences with parents during class time.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Workshops fee must be paid in full without deduction for absences for any reason or any duration.

Staffing and other operational costs are incurred on the basis of fixed levels of enrollment. These costs are not eliminated when a child is absent. Workshops that do not enroll a required minimum number of students 5 business days prior to workshop meeting may be canceled. Young People that have paid for canceled workshop will receive a refund or may apply credit to another workshop. Workshops can be canceled up to 5 business prior to workshops convening.

There will be a \$25 cancelation fee. YPW will not refund the workshop fee after a workshop has started or when the cancelation notice is received within 5 business days prior to starting the workshop.

A \$30 fee is charged for all returned checks.
