What are the qualifications of your teachers and assistants?

All of our teachers are certified school teachers or highly trained professionals with extensive experience in their respective fields. They all have experience working with children and enjoy handson interactive activities.

How are campers supervised?

Campers are supervised at all times. For your child's security all campers MUST be escorted to and from their camp room by a parent or guardian and signed in and out EVERY DAY.
