

## **REVIEWING SPANISH WITH YOUR CHILDREN AT HOME**

- When you purchase your favorite kid shows and movies on dvd's, make sure it has the Spanish audio track as well (Spanish subtitles are a great help too). Watch it in English a few times, then watch it in Spanish. After watching it in Spanish a couple of times, make a game out of it by listening out for the Spanish words and phrases you all recognize.

## SOME MORE IDEAS ...

- 1. In the morning, sing a Spanish "hello" or "good morning" song. Ask your teacher to teach it to you.
- 2. Gently lift your baby up and down say "arriba" "abajo." or, lift his / her arms if older child
- 3. Open and close your hands and say "abierto" "cerrado"
- 4. Name the food and beverages you give in Spanish.

• Aqua = water Leche = milk Jugo = juice Jugo de naranja = orange juice

- Jugo de manzana = apple juice Jugo de uva = grape juice Cereal = cereal Bread = pan
- Rice = arroz Galletas = crackers/cookies

Almost finished = Casi terminaste

5. Make simple comments and ask simple questions when it's eating time.

- Here you go = Aquí tienes Let's pray (say grace) = Oremos Mmm, yummy = muy rico
  - Finished? = iTerminaste? Want more? = iQuieres r
- Yay! You ate all = ¡Comiste todo! No more. = No mas. Do you want something to drink? ¿Quieres algo para tomar?
- Mmm, yummy = muy rico Want more? = ¿Quieres mas?
