- Recognizes and copies patterns

Scientific Thinking & Problem Solving

- Works with the class to gather and interpret data (building graphs)
- Knows and names major body parts

Language & Communication Development

- Uses new vocabulary and grammar in everyday communications
- Answers questions to demonstrate comprehension of read text

Creativity & The Arts

- Draws / paints recognizable pictures – some of the time

Physical Development

- Uses strength and control to perform fine motor skills
- Follows basic safety and health rules

Personal & Social Development

- Seeks adult help needed
- Participates successfully as a member of a group
